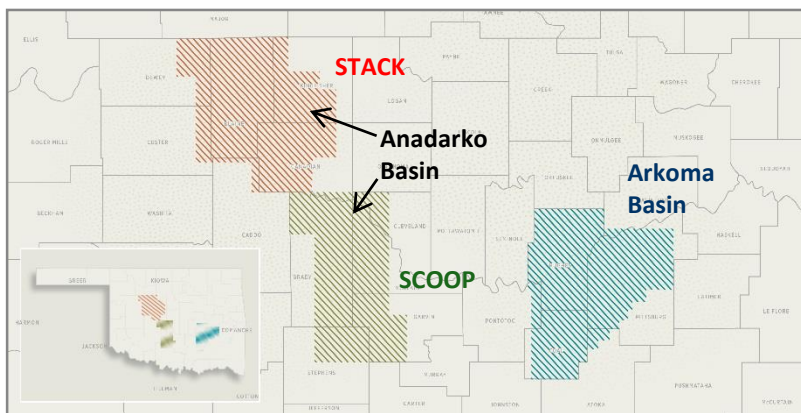
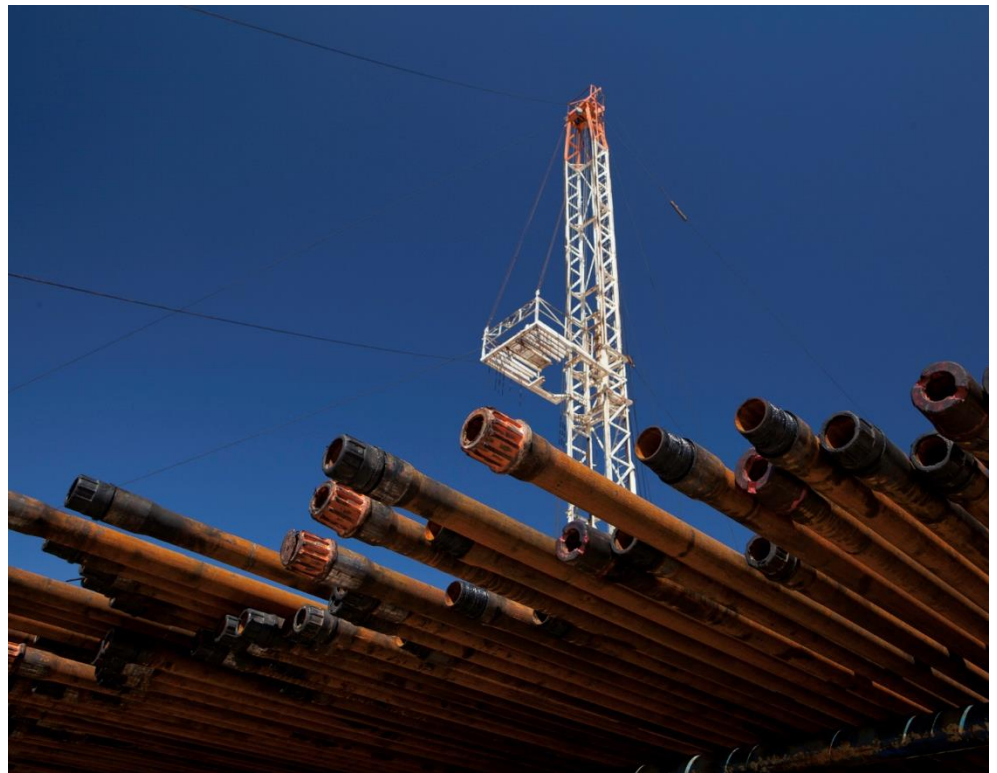


# Newfield Exploration Company (NYSE: NFX)

## Oklahoma

Newfield has been active in Oklahoma since 2001 where more than 60 percent of the Company's proved reserves and daily production are located. Newfield's acreage includes nearly 550,000 net acres covering key positions in the liquids-rich SCOOP and STACK plays in the Anadarko Basin and in the dry gas Arkoma Basin Woodford. Newfield began to assemble its position in the Anadarko Basin in 2012 and has grown its position to approximately 400,000 net acres today. In total, Newfield has drilled more than 900 horizontal wells in the state of Oklahoma.



### Arkoma Woodford

Newfield was a founder of the Arkoma Woodford shale development and currently has approximately 147,000 net acres in this play. At year-end 2016, the area represented about 12 percent of the Company's domestic proved reserves, and net production was approximately 16,000 BOEPD (98% dry gas). The majority of Newfield's acreage in the Arkoma is held-by production.

### Anadarko Basin

The STACK holds more than 700 feet of saturated hydrocarbon intervals. To date, Newfield has drilled approximately 500 horizontal wells in the Anadarko Basin, yielding high volumes of oil, natural gas liquids and natural gas. The Company plans to invest nearly \$900 million in SCOOP and STACK in 2017, and operate about 10 drilling rigs throughout the year. At year end 2016, Newfield's net production from the Anadarko Basin was approximately 88,000 BOEPD (34% oil, 27% NGLs).
